- IUCN, WEDO and WOCAN will be launching the Global Initiative on REDD+ and Gender Equality at the forthcoming 16th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC CoP16).

 - Ensure that global and national REDD+ efforts are gender responsive;
 - Leverage women's leadership to mitigate the effects of climate change;
 - c. Align with sustainable development goals; and
 - d. Alleviate poverty.

- 4. The side event will bring together a panel of women leaders and REDD experts to share perspectives, and discuss how a gender approach and women's empowerment are essential to a successful implementation of REDD initiatives.
- 5. This side event will offer concrete recommendations for REDD initiatives at the national level, as well as criteria for the international standards and guidelines that are being debated during COP 16.
- 6. Panelists include leaders of Tebtebba, IUCN, CARE, women's groups managing community forests in Nepal, WOCAN and representatives of the Norwegian and Mexican governments
- For the occasion, all participants women and men that believe that women <u>can</u> make a difference in REDD initiatives are requested to wear red to show their solidarity.
